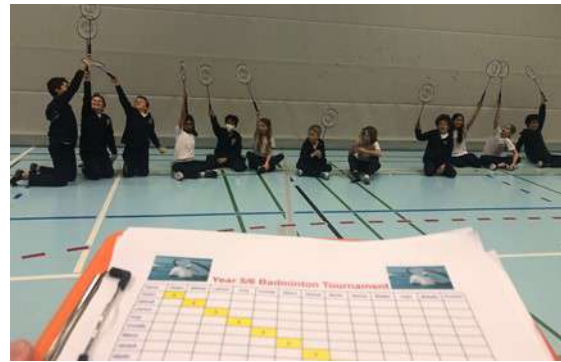


YEAR 5 AND 6

Working together on our Greek myth.

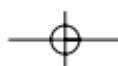
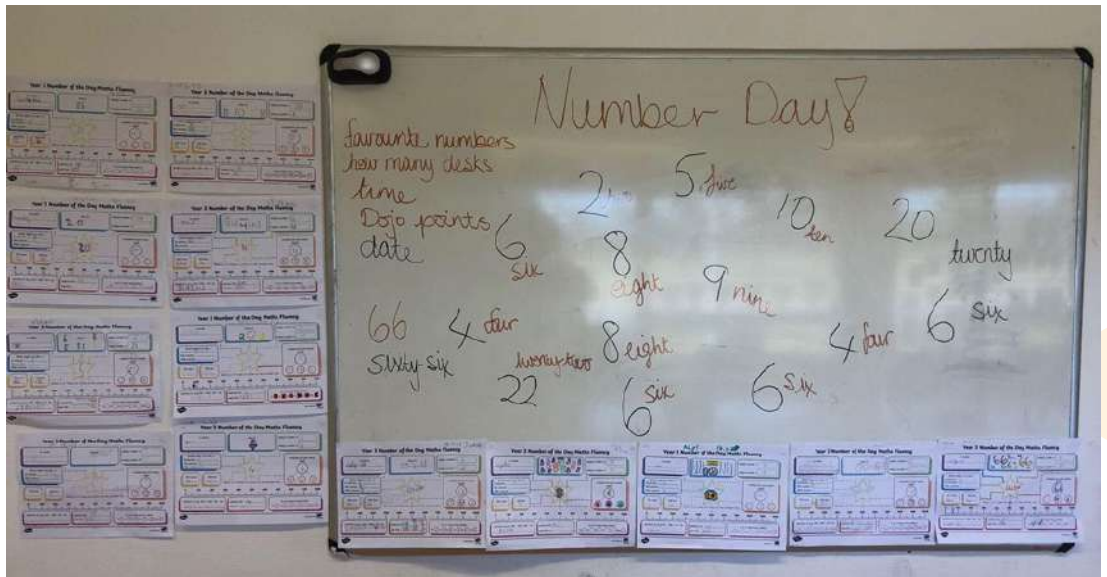


The year 5 and 6 badminton tournament has started!

We have enjoyed being fossil hunters in our sensory play area and also in science making our very own volcanoes which we took to the science lab on Friday and had a go at making them erupt!





Focus on uniform

Expectations:-

Please be reminded that as a British International school, our students are expected to wear their full school uniform when attending school. Jeans of any kind are not acceptable.

In addition, the expectation for footwear is that our students wear completely black trainers or shoes. If you will be buying your son/ daughter new footwear in the near future please ensure that they meet this requirement.

All students sitting IGCSE or A Level examinations this year must wear their uniform to sit their terminal examinations.

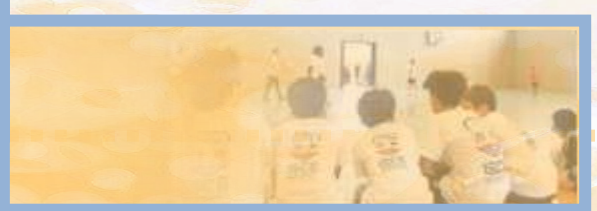
ISCS House Competition

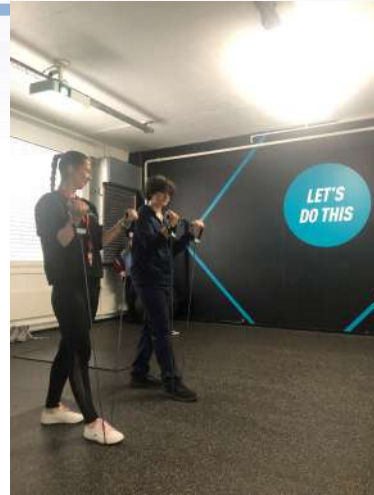
