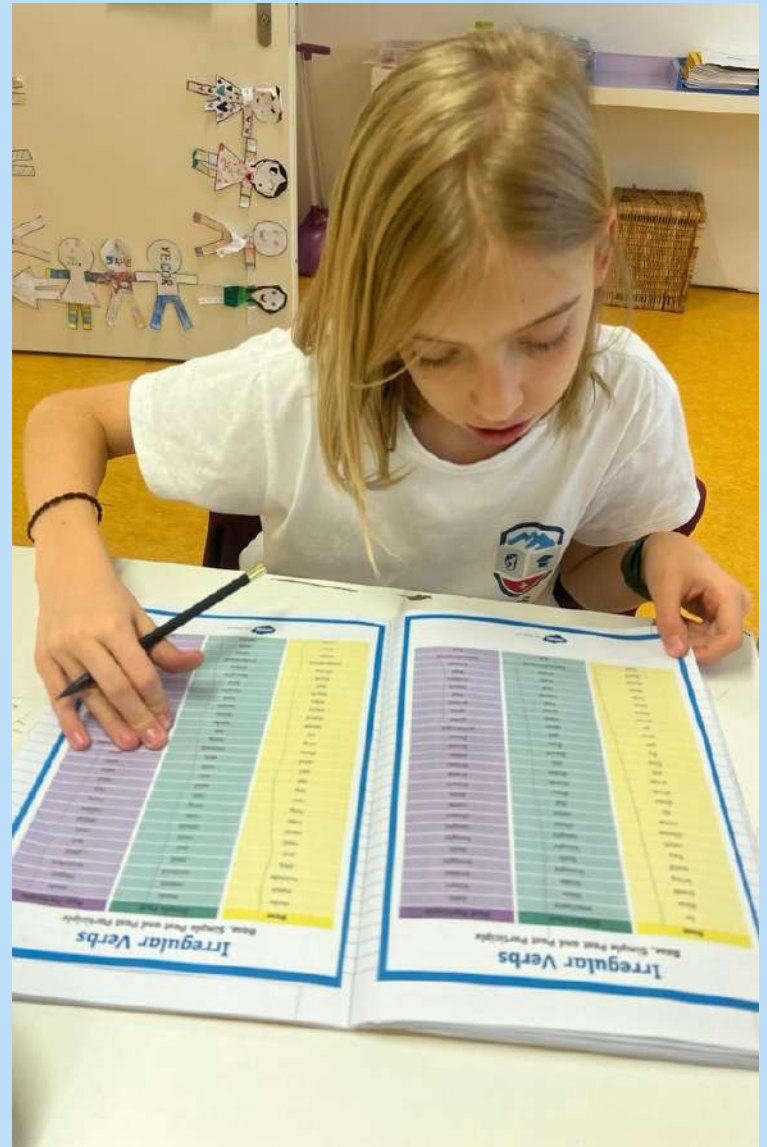




# - PRIMARY NEWS -
