Respect and excellence are core values at our school.



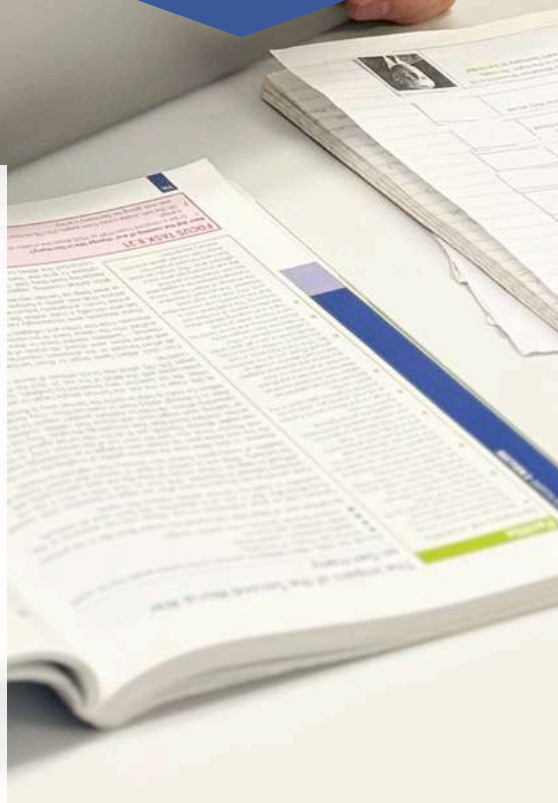

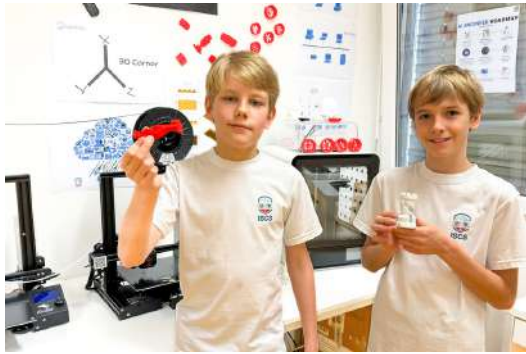
