I would like to wish everyone a lovely weekend.




Dear Parents,


Engineering Club: A Space to Explore Technology

AS Media students have been covering introductory units on the topics of semiotics and micro-elements. They have been applying media theory to activities involving different types of camera shots, angles and editing.






Football unit in PE


