

Dear ISCS Community,

At ISCS, we place great importance on German as one of our core subjects. We offer a comprehensive curriculum across the whole school. In Early Years, students enjoy four German language lessons per week, as well as having two teachers present in every session - one speaking in German to reinforce ideas while the lead teacher instructs in English.

From Year 1 to Year 11, students follow one of four levels we offer in each year group — Beginners, Intermediate, Advanced, or Native — ensuring that every learner receives the right level of challenge and support to make steady progress.

Students can also pursue IGCSE First and Second Language German, A Level German, and Goethe C1 Accreditation preparation, opening doors to universities in Switzerland and abroad.

Learning German goes far beyond the classroom. Our students experience the language in Forest School, through educational trips, and in daily interactions. Just today, Year 10 visited the National Museum in Zürich, bringing the language and culture to life.

Mastering German supports not only academic growth, but also integration into the local community and valuable future networking opportunities.

I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks and congratulations to the German Department, led by Ulrike Sauer, for their exceptional work and dedication. Danke schön!

This week in German classes across Primary, students learned about the Swiss tradition of Räbeliechtli. They explored the history of the festival, sang songs, and carved traditional turnip lanterns. A big thank-you to the PTO for planning this event and giving our students the opportunity to experience this unique part of Swiss culture.

Räbeliechtli is a Swiss autumn tradition where children carve lanterns from turnips (Räben) and carry them in evening processions, singing songs as they light up the dark. The celebration marks the change of seasons and symbolizes warmth and community as winter approaches.




A special shout-out also goes to Ben and Andrea from Year 12, who took on the roles of referee and assistant coaches and did a fantastic job supporting both teams.






Year 9 – Exploring Professional 3D Design with Fusion 360 In Computer Science, our Year 9 students have embarked on an exciting journey into the world of professional 3D design using Fusion 360 by Autodesk. This powerful design software, widely used in industries such as engineering, architecture, and product development, allows students to experience real-world digital creation.

Through these lessons, students are learning to transform their ideas into precise 3D models, developing both their technical and creative thinking skills. The project also highlights the cross-curricular importance of mathematics, as students apply geometric concepts, accurate measurements, and spatial reasoning to ensure their designs are both functional and realistic. This hands-on approach helps them see how Computer Science, design, and math work together to solve real-world challenges.


