REGISTRATION FEE

After ISCS receives the signed enrolment contract, an invoice for the non-refundable registration fee will be issued. Upon receipt of payment, a place will be guaranteed at ISCS. Please note that payment is required upon enrollment. The registration fee is a one-off payment and will not offset year group fees.

PAYMENT OF FEES

The full annual year group fee is payable for the entire academic year in advance for each student enrolled or re-enrolled. If a new student is enrolled and thereafter does not take up the place on the confirmed start date, 25% of the annual year group tuition fee is due and payable immediately.

Alternative payment methods may be available. Families seeking payment plans will be required to sign a formalised payment schedule agreement. An annual interest rate of 5% and collection fees may be added to overdue balances.

ENROLMENT DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR

If enrollment takes place during the academic year, the contract of enrollment is valid from the student's starting date and is automatically renewed for the following academic year, unless written confirmation of termination is received and confirmed with the signed withdrawal form before March 31st of the current academic year. Prorated tuition fees are due in advance for the remaining academic year.
