Wishing all students continued focus and success in the days ahead.

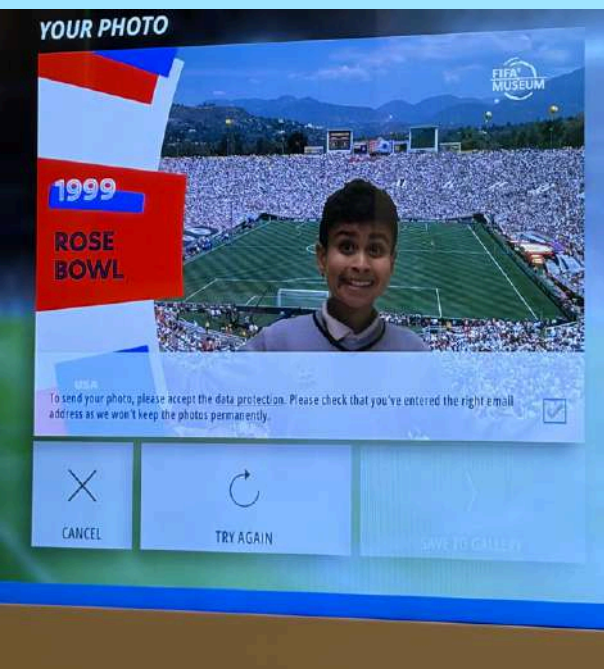

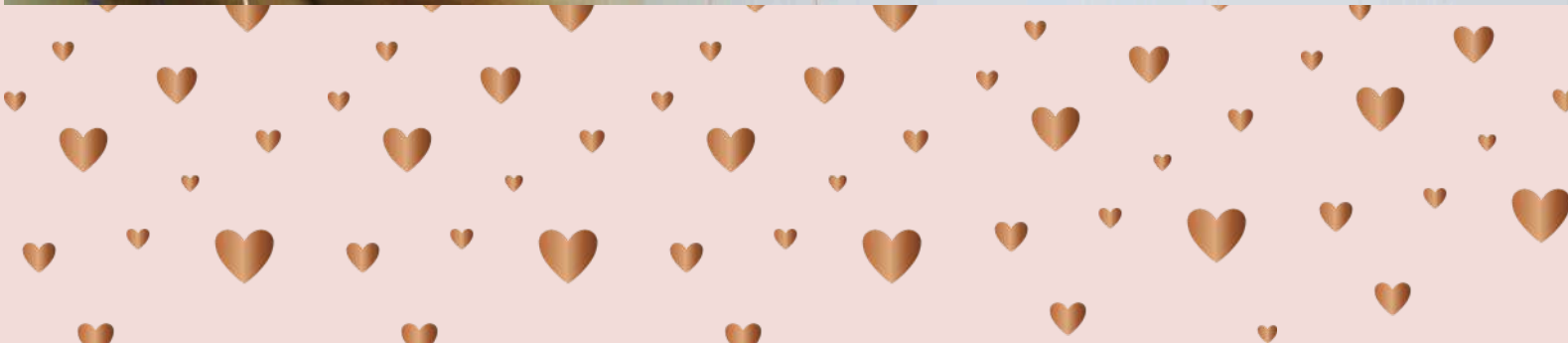
