A CHAT WITH AN ASTRONAUT



On Friday, our pupils had the exciting opportunity to meet Pablo Álvarez Fernández, Spain's first fully certified astronaut in 31 years. Pablo, who was selected by the European Space Agency from more than 22,500 applicants and qualified as an ESA astronaut in 2024, shared his journey from aerospace engineering to astronaut training and future missions to the International Space Station. The visit was especially meaningful for our school following the recent success of two Year 12 pupils in the prestigious Astro Pi Mission Space Lab programme. Their experiment earned "flight status" and will run aboard the International Space Station between April and May 2026, collecting real scientific data in orbit. Meeting a real astronaut brought their achievement to life and offered a fascinating insight into the opportunities that STEM subjects can create. A special thank you goes to Mr Alvarez for organising it, and whose passion for Computer Science continues to inspire pupils to reach for the stars.

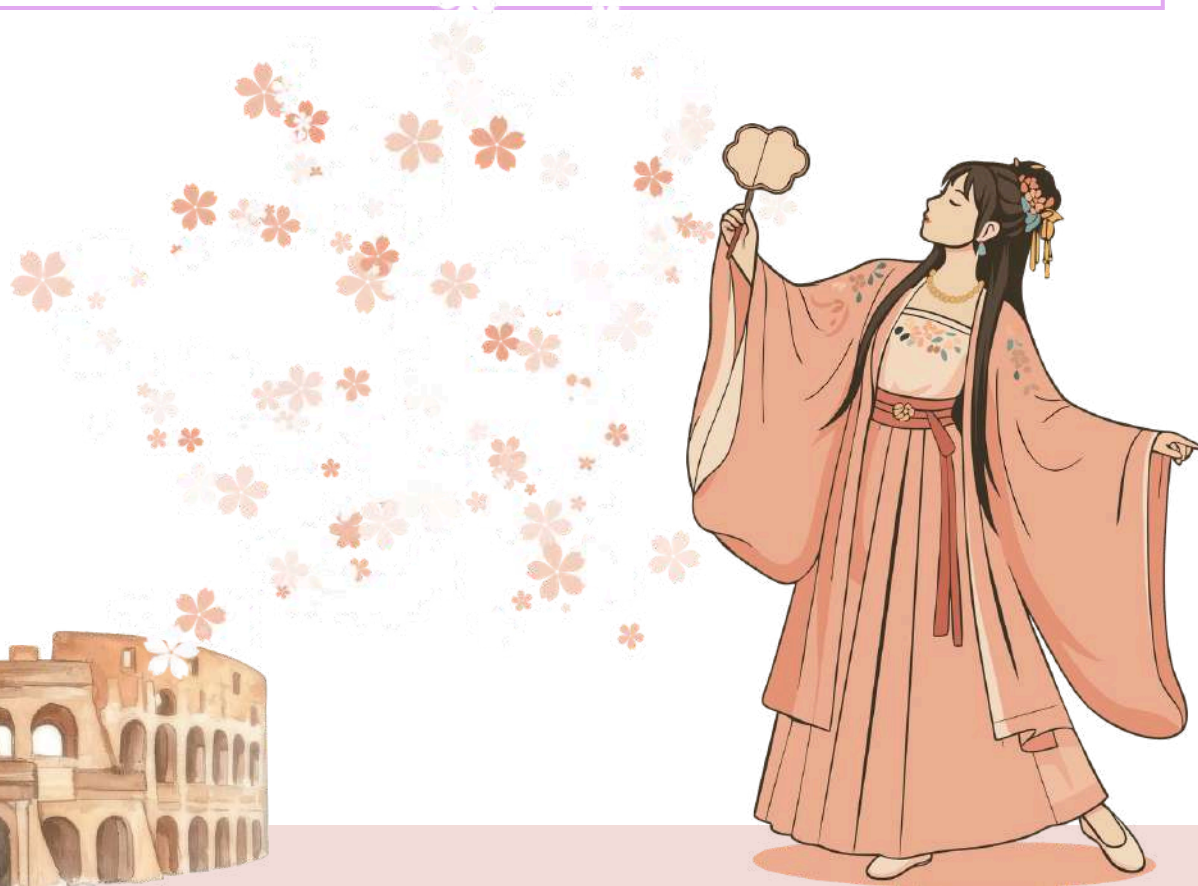
